

2023 SACI AWARDS – JAMES MOIR MEDALS

(For recognition of achievements in 2022)

THE JAMES MOIR MEDALS

The medals shall be known as the **James Moir Medals of the South African Chemical Institute.** The medals are struck in bronze and bear the Institute's name and crest on the obverse, and the name of the medal together with the name of the recipient and the date on the reverse. Medals shall be awarded to the best student who has completed a course in any branch of chemistry at **NQF level 8 (Honours or Postgraduate Diploma)** at each University and University of Technology, and achieved an **average final mark of at least 75%**. One medal shall be available for award annually for each University and University of Technology in the Republic of South Africa. The medal shall be accompanied by a suitably inscribed scroll.

PROCEDURE FOR NOMINATION/APPLICATION

The merits of the work of candidates may be brought to the notice of the Council by the Heads of the Departments of Chemistry who desire to recommend candidates (nominations).

Past medalists are ineligible for nomination for a second award (in case of a second qualification within the NRF level 8).

Nominations should be received by the Institute not later than 31 May 2023.

The Council may at its discretion suspend any or all of these awards in any year in which there are no suitable candidates.
