THE JAMES MOIR MEDALS

The medals shall be known as the **James Moir Medals of the South African Chemical Institute**. The medals are struck in bronze, and bear the Institute's name and crest on the obverse, and the name of the medal together with the name of the recipient and the date on the reverse. Medals shall be awarded to the best fourth year student in chemistry at each University and University of Technology. **To be eligible for the award the student must have achieved a minimum average final pass mark of 75%.** One medal shall be available for award annually for each University and University of Technology in the Republic of South Africa. The medal shall be accompanied by a suitably inscribed scroll.

PROCEDURE FOR NOMINATION/APPLICATION

The merits of the work of candidates may be brought to the notice of the Council by the Heads of the Departments of Chemistry who desire to recommend candidates (nominations).

Nominations should be received by the Institute not later than 31 May 2020.

The Council may at its discretion suspend any or all of these awards in any year in which there are no suitable candidates.
